Travel arrangements

- We have requested children to travel with other children from their bubble on the school buses
- Children over the age of 11 can wear masks if they wish

Arrangements for entering school

- All children will have their temperatures taken before entering school and use hand sanitiser
- Any child who displays a high temperature or illness symptoms will not be allowed in school
- Children will come into from school from 2 entrances, but all buses will park in the main carpark
- We would like to see children in clean school uniform

Once in school

- Your child will stay in their form/class group all day including lunch time and break times and not mix with other classes
- We will promote social distancing as much as possible
- Children will be encouraged to wash their hands as much as possible and use hand sanitiser throughout the day
- There will be a one way system in place to follow
- Very strict cleaning regimes will be in place including cleaning all the resources the child has used that day
- Children will be taught outside as much as possible- weather permitting
- PPE will be available to staff if required but MUST be worn with personal care and feeding
- If your child displays any of the following symptoms: high temperature, rash, sickness, diarrhoea, sore throat, loss of taste and smell, then they will be not be allowed to stay in school and you will be asked to collect your child immediately and take them for a COVID 19 test
- We do have very strict protocols in place if a child does contract COVID 19- see flow diagram on web site
- There will be no swimming or P.E initially and this will be reviewed regularly
- Lunch will be a packed lunch provided by the school kitchen or from home. Children who require a specialised diet will be provided with the appropriate food
